

How to Make the Log Cabin

Materials

- printer
- 6 sheets of cardstock or printer paper
- markers, crayons, or colored pencils
- scissors
- glue or tape (A glue stick works best.)

Directions

1. **Print** the cabin pieces.
(If the dotted lines don't print, be sure you saved the file to your computer instead of opening it with an Internet browser.)
2. **Color** the rocks on the fireplace. If you printed on white paper, you'll also want to color your logs and roof. Add people or curtains to the windows.
3. **Cut** out the pieces by cutting on the dark, dashed lines. — — — — — — — — — —
Don't forget to cut the dark, dashed lines that make the door as well as the small slits at the end of the logs. (Do **NOT** cut the gray dotted lines.)
4. **Fold** on the gray dotted lines. -----
 - **Fold** the door open.
 - **Fold** the tabs at the end of the logs backwards. (These say "glue.")
 - **Fold** the roof tabs backwards (or cut them off if you don't want to permanently attach the roof).
 - **Fold** the roof in half lengthwise.
5. **Glue** the fireplace to the side of the house.
6. Select a side of the cabin to attach to the front. Line up the bottom edges and fit the protruding log ends into the holes on the opposite piece. Then turn both pieces over to the back and turn the tabs so you can see the word "glue." Put glue on each tab and fold it flat to glue. Do this to attach all 4 walls of the cabin together. Check out the video for help with this step.
7. **Place** the roof on top of the cabin so the cutout aligns with the top of the fireplace. **Glue** the tabs to the roof.

Finally, if you are printing on A4 paper (as opposed to 8.5 x 11), the long edges of the roof may not print in entirety. If this is the case, simply fold your paper in half lengthwise. No need to cut the long edges.

How to Make the Outhouse

Materials

- printer
- 2 sheets of cardstock or printer paper
- markers or colored pencils (optional)
- scissors
- glue or tape (A glue stick works best.)

Directions

8. **Print** the pieces.
(If the dotted lines don't print, be sure you saved the file to your computer instead of opening it with an Internet browser.)
9. **Color** if you'd like to.
10. **Cut** out the pieces by cutting on the dark, dashed lines. — — — — —
Don't forget to cut the dark, dashed lines that make the door.
(Do **NOT** cut the gray dotted lines.)
11. **Fold** on the gray dotted lines. -----
 - **Fold** the door forwards.
 - **Fold** backwards on the tabs on the front.
 - **Fold** backwards on all dotted lines on the seat.
 - **Fold** forwards on all the dotted lines on the main section (page 2).
12. **Glue** roof tabs to the sides of the outhouse (page 2).
13. **Glue** the seat inside the outhouse.
14. **Glue** the front tabs to the sides and roof.

You're done!
