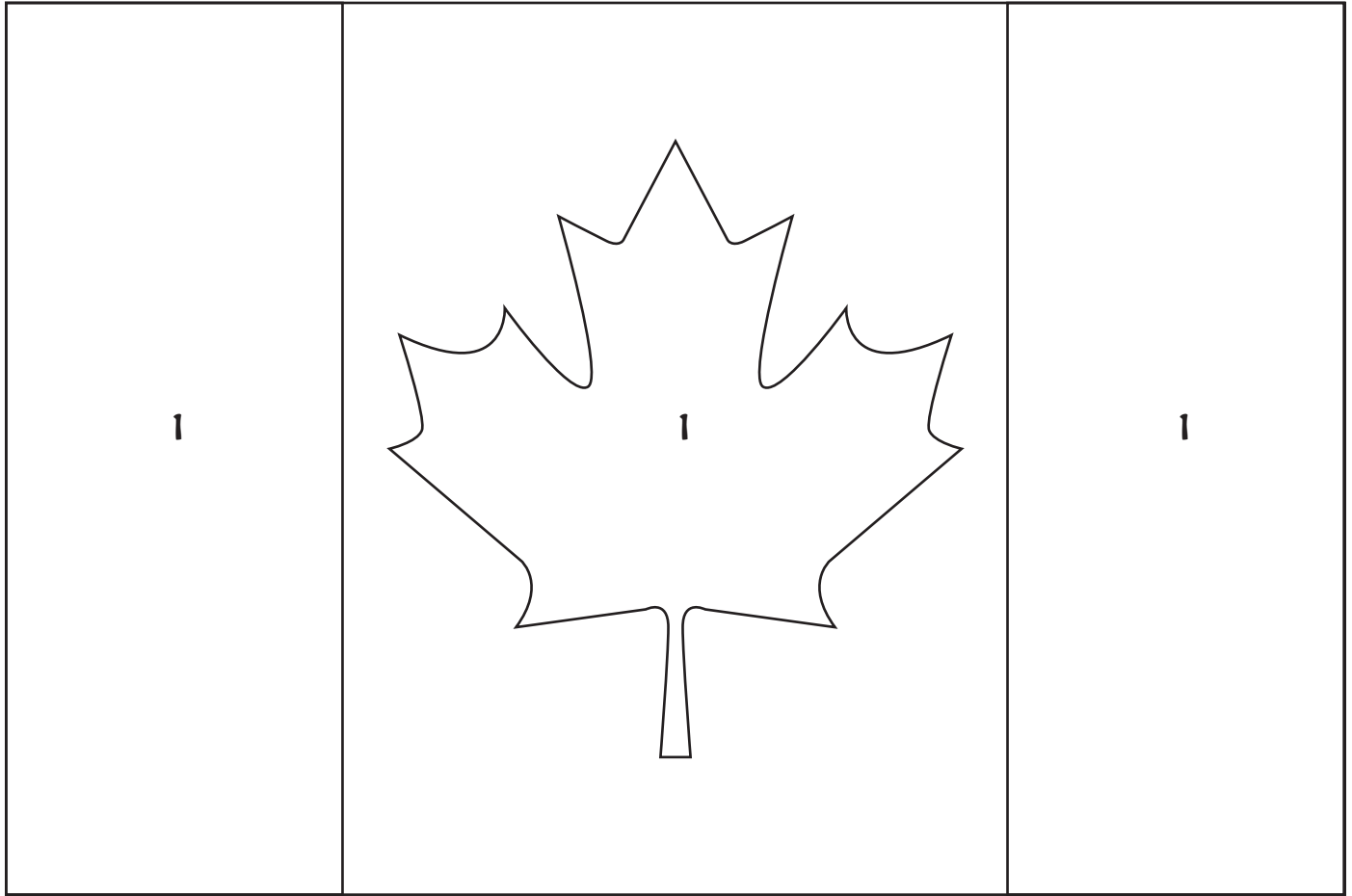

Color in the beaver below.



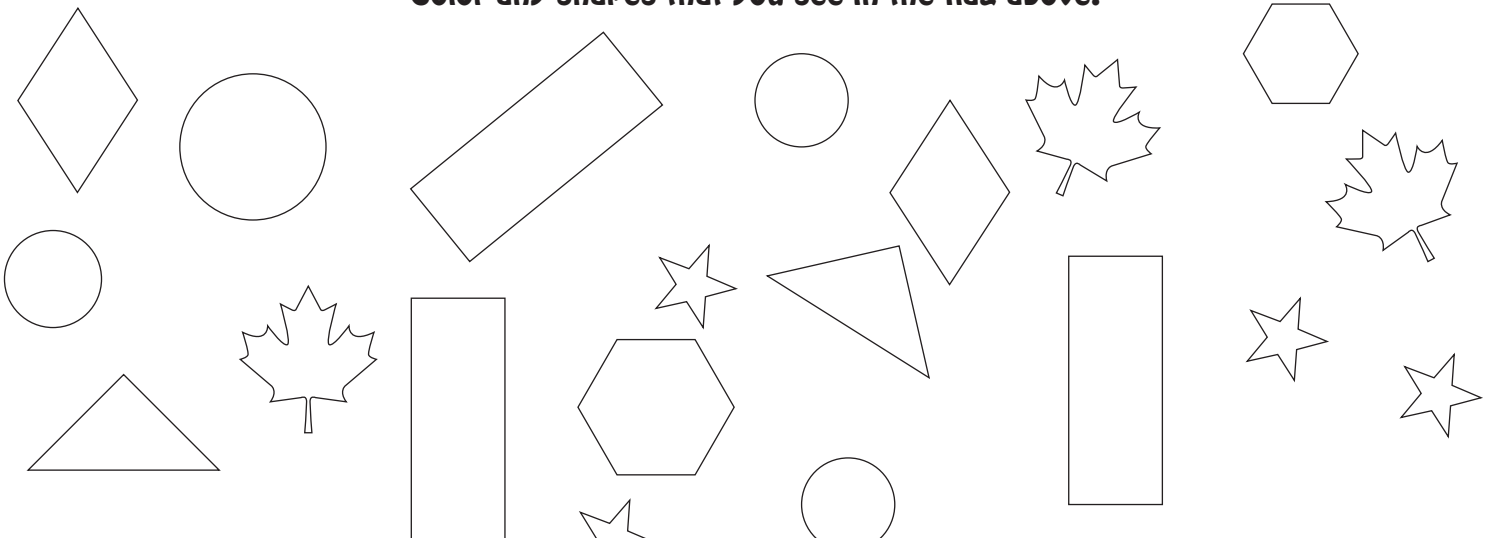
Color the Flag - Canada!

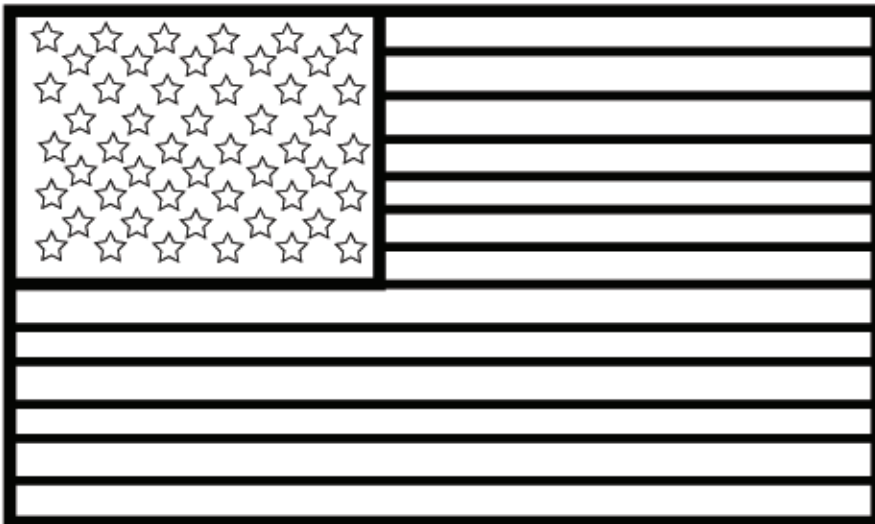


United States Symbols

Bald Eagle

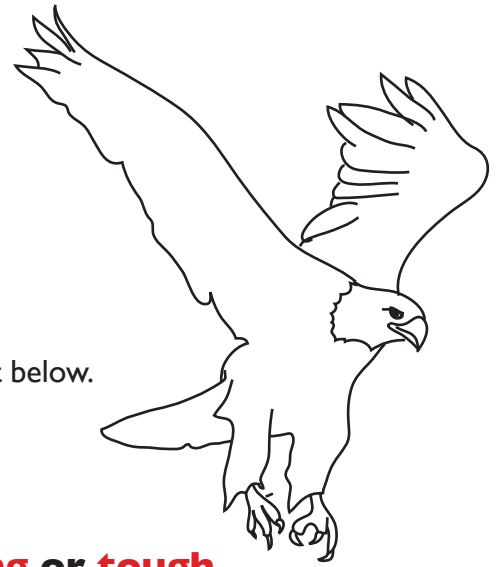
The bald eagle was chosen as the emblem of the United States in 1782 because of its long life, strength and majestic appearance. Above all, the eagle represents freedom. The eagle appears on many important documents and many gold and silver coins.



The American Flag

The American flag is a symbol for unity and liberty. Many older versions of the flag had words like “hope” & “liberty” on them. In 1818 the flag with 13 stripes and stars for each state was created. The red stands for hardiness and valor, white symbolizes purity and innocence, while blue is the symbol for vigilance, perseverance and justice.
